Tanzania and Time:

Teaching planning skills and time management requires patience and understanding. In an agrarian society with little or no technology, IT or keeping a schedule and planning seems over-rated. The seasons of the harvest and rains govern time here, as does the rites of passage and life events. Funerals, weddings, circumcision are calendar events. Rains, transport problems, deaths or births may upset previously arranged plans and don't require any notice. Everyone is faced with difficulties and it is assumed there is understanding. Tanzanians are sometimes offended by the way Europeans slavishly listen to the small round things on their wrist called watches. They have a lot of power to interrupt relationship. **Quiet chats are where changes come from, not busy schedules.** This has been a challenge for us. The Swahili saying encapsulates the Tanzanian mindset: "Haraka haraka haina baraka" translated Hurry & you'll miss the blessing.

Business as Mission:

In April we are having our first BaM seminar:

Business has the potential to bring God's blessings to people and give them the opportunity to rise out of spiritual, social and physical poverty. As we focus in on the particular strategy of business as mission, let us first understand and embrace the fullness of God's design for business.

"In our society we become what we celebrate. In order to release business people to get engaged, we need to celebrate their role in the Kingdom of God. We need to stop celebrating one call, one role over another call or role. Business is a high calling, we need to celebrate it so that our children and their children know that if they are called to business then that's what they should be doing to God's glory"
